Criteria for Canadian Applicants Going to Australia

Applicant must be between 16-21 years of age as of January 1st, 2017.

Applicant must currently be a Junior Member of the Canadian Limousin Association.

Applicant must have a valid passport that does not expire within the next three months of the travel dates.

Applicant cannot be awarded this trip more than once.

Program

The successful applicants will spend four weeks with an Australian Limousin host family or multiple host families on their operations. The successful applicants will have the choice of going to Australia during February/March and attending the Sydney Royal Show (Sydney, New South Wales) or going during August and attending the Ekka Royal Queensland Show (Brisbane, Queensland). While staying with their host families the successful applicants are expected to assist the host families with farm chores, show/sale cattle preparation, and at the show(s)/sale(s) if applicable. This is a working holiday.

Approximate travel dates will be the applicant's choice of either February 15, 2017 to March 20, 2017 or August 1, 2017 to September 5, 2017.

Two applicants will be selected each year that the program continues.

The Canadian Junior Limousin Association (CJLA) will award the successful applicants with \$1,000 CAD each to assist with travel expenses.

The successful applicants will be given complementary accommodations and meals by the host family.
