Neogen Canada Acquires Delta Genomics

As of January 1, 2019 Neogen Canada has acquired Delta Genomics and is now the official supplier of genomics testing for the CLA. The majority of the Delta staff has continued on through this change which means we will see the same level of great service. We will also see an improved turnaround time of 21 calendar days for genetic testing. Perhaps the most positive change for our membership is the significant cost savings on all genetic testing. Please be sure to review the new fee schedule. The lab mailing address remains the same and for the time being you can continue to send hair in the existing envelopes.

Delta Genomics sells genotyping services to global genomics company; secures improved genomics servicing deal for Canadian livestock producers and researchers

EDMONTON, Alberta - Delta Genomics Centre (Delta) has sold its genotyping services in an asset sale to Neogen Canada Inc. (Neogen Canada), a subsidiary of Neogen Corporation (NASDAQ: NEOG). With the acquisition, Delta's laboratory operations will continue under Neogen Canada and become Neogen's fifth animal genomics laboratory worldwide. The acquisition will help ensure more affordable genomics services to drive greater adoption of genomic technologies throughout the Canadian livestock industry.

"This is an excellent opportunity for the Canadian Livestock industry," says Graham Plastow, Delta's board chair. "The sale of our genomics services to Neogen Canada will provide us with extra resources to support the development of value-added genomics tools for our industry while maintaining high quality genomic services for our clients."

Neogen Canada will maintain its operations in Edmonton, Alberta and Delta Genomics will continue its mission to improve the sustainability, profitability and competitiveness of the Canadian livestock industry. Delta Genomics' CEO Michelle Miller is named the new general manager of Neogen Canada and will continue to work with the Delta Genomics board of directors to support customers during the transition.

Reminder- Transferring Animals Online

Please note that if a registration paper has been printed for an animal you are no longer able to transfer that animal online, you must instead fill out and sign the back of the registration paper and send it into the CLA office. You can transfer animals online if the registration paper has never been printed. Remember: leave the "Send me the Certificate?" option unchecked when registering calves if you do not require a hard copy registration paper - then you will be able to transfer that animal online at a later date. Please note CLA staff cannot transfer animals on your behalf via a phone or email request, but we are always happy to assist you in doing it online yourself.

The CLTS MOBO app is essentially the Canadian Livestock Tracking System database at your fingertips. We've taken the entirety of a national traceability system and made it available on your Android and iPhone devices. Our MOBO app launched in 2010 in its basic form, as a response to the growing demand to operate a business anywhere, anytime. MOBO is our solution, with the flexibility to be portable and on-the-go while meeting increasing demands for livestock traceability regulations.'

The app is now more user-friendly than ever with streamlined features and intuitive design. The new Offline Mode allows users to input-data and upload when it makes sense for them; when the job is finished or when they are back in a service area.

CLTS MOBO allows users to submit birthdates, animal movement and retired events (to name a few), directly to the CLTS database. CLTS MOBO features Optical Character Recognition technology, which converts images of number lists into editable, searchable data for easy uploads to your CLTS account.

With changing traceability regulations expected for 2019, there is no better time to sign-up for the app. Producers will have increased responsibilities including timely reporting of data, transportation information and premise identification obligations in order to be considered compliant. The Canadian Cattle Identification Agency is making it easier than ever to keep your records up-to-date and stay accountable.
