Criteria for Canadian Applicants Going to Australia

Applicant must be between 16-21 years of age as of January 1st, 2016.

Applicant must currently be a Junior Member of the Canadian Limousin Association.

Applicant must have a valid passport that does not expire within the next three months of the travel dates.

Applicant cannot be awarded this trip more than once.

Program

The successful applicant will spend four weeks with an Australian Limousin host family or multiple host families on their operations. The successful applicant will have the choice of going to Australia during the month of April and attending the Sydney Royal Show (Sydney, New South Wales) or going during the last two weeks of July and first two weeks of August and attending the Ekka Royal Queensland Show (Brisbane, Queensland). While staying with their host families the successful applicant(s) are expected to assist the host families with farm chores, show/sale cattle preparation, and at the show(s)/sale(s) if applicable. This is a working holiday.

Approximate travel dates will be the applicant's choice of either April 1-30, 2016 or July 15, 2016 to August 15, 2016.

One applicant will be selected each year that the program continues.

The Canadian Junior Limousin Association (CJLA) will award the successful applicant with \$2,000 CAD to assist with travel expenses.

The successful applicant will be given complementary accommodations and meals by the host family.

- 2) Click on Herd Management
- 3) Click on Inventory
- 4) Select the Assessment-Age tab at the top of the page, this will show a list of your females that are of assessment age

- 6) Click the green ball with the check mark
- 7) If you have made a mistake and do not want to dispose of a particular female click the red X
- 8) When all females needing disposal have a disposal code selected, you may then click assess and all females who have not been disposed of will be assessed in your WHE.
